

## Guidelines for filing Nominations in Election 2010

As you all know, for the membership of the committees decided in the structure for the Student Government at DA-IICT, elections will be held on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2010. The following committees will be elected as part of the Student Government:

1. Academic Committee
2. Annual Festival Committee
3. Cafeteria Committee (Including off-campus also)
4. Cultural Committee
5. Hostel Management Committee
6. Sports Committee
7. (Student members on) Placement Committee

Details about the committees regarding their responsibilities can be found in the student government document on the intranet. Representation in each committee from each batch is as follows:-

Therefore, nominations, for the election of the representatives in the above mentioned committees, are invited.

### **Eligibility Criteria:-**

- Anyone who is **not** on either **academic or disciplinary probation**<sup>1</sup> will be eligible for contesting in elections for all the committees, except for the academic committee (which has additional criteria listed below):-
  1. Undergraduates Minimum C.P.I. of 7.0  
Post-graduates Minimum C.P.I. of 8.0
  2. The representatives should not have secured an 'F' Grade in any course.

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<sup>1</sup> **Academic or disciplinary probation** means that no disciplinary action has been taken against the candidate and his/her CPI and his/her last semester SPI must not be below **5.0**.

- A person cannot hold more than one post in a term. A person can stand for only one post in an election.
- First, second and third year B. Tech. students, first year M.Tech., MS-IT, MS-ITA and M.Des. students, and all Ph.D. students will participate in the elections. These criteria are derived from the student government model. Any further clarifications regarding any issue can be found in the above mentioned document.

### **How to apply:-**

Submit the completed form for filing the nomination duly filled which is present on the intranet. You need to take a print out of that document.

### **How to withdraw:**

Submit the completed form for withdrawing the nomination duly filled which is present on the intranet. You need to take a print out of that document.

### **Where to submit:-**

The nomination paper can be submitted to any of the following election officers:-

The nomination paper can be submitted to them any time, but for your convenience from **11:00 pm to 12:00 midnight** they will be in their room. Do not forget to bring your **smart card** along with you otherwise your nomination form will not be accepted.

### **Your nomination stands to be cancelled if:**

- You are found to be participating in any event that involves violating the code of conduct in any manner.
- You are found to have submitted more than one nomination while we are preparing the final list after the deadline of filing the nomination and have not withdrawn any one of the nomination till that time.
- You have provided any wrong information in the nomination form about yourself

### **Important Note:-**

No elections will be held for a particular committee in a particular category if the number of nominations is less than or equal to the number of representatives required in a committee for that particular category. Eligible candidates who have filled their nominations will be elected unopposed.

*For Example,* Number of Nominations for Annual Festival Committee in the category- MS-IT, MS-IT-A, M. Des, M-Tech, Ph. D. is less than or equal to 3(Requirement as stated by student government), then eligible candidates who have filled their nominations will straightway get elected.
